



1st Circular the 5th IOAA-jr 2026

Dear Members,

We are delighted to invite you to the 5th International Olympiad on Astronomy and Astrophysics - Junior (IOAA-jr2026), which will be hosted in Ubon Ratchathani, THAILAND, from 1st November 2026 (arrival) to 8th November 2026 (departure). The event will bring together young minds from across the globe to engage in collaborative learning and friendly competition.

This year's Olympiad is jointly hosted by **The Promotion of Academic Olympiad and Development of Science Education Foundation (POSN)** under the patronage of Her Royal Highness Princess Galyani Vadhana Krom Luang Naradhiwas Rajanagarindra, together with **Ubon Ratchathani Province, Ubon Ratchathani University (UBU), and the National Astronomical Research Institute of Thailand (NARIT)**.

A significant inspiration behind organizing the IOAA-jr 2026 is the celebration of the **72nd birthday anniversary of Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn on 2nd April 2027**. Her longstanding support for education and the promotion of scientific knowledge has profoundly influenced generations of students across Thailand, nurturing future thinkers, innovators, and leaders.

Important Dates:

Pre-registration opens:	10 th February 2026
Pre-registration closes:	20 th March 2026
Main Registration opens:	20th April 2026 15 th May 2026
Main Registration closes:	30 th June 2026
Opening Ceremony of IOAA-jr 2026:	2 nd November 2026 – 09.30 AM- 12.00 PM
Closing Ceremony of IOAA-jr 2026:	8 th November 2026 – 10.00 AM - 12.00 PM

Team Composition and Fees:

- **Main teams:** This initial phase focuses specifically on Main Teams. There will be fees for main teams of up to 5 students and 2 team leaders. The fee for main teams will be 500 EUR per person.
- We are preparing for 30 Main teams and may accept/accommodate guest teams for this edition of the competition provided that we have available space (The fee for Guest teams will be 1,000 EUR per person).
- **Observers:** Each observer is required to pay a registration fee of 1,000 EUR per person.

Accommodation and Logistics:

- All participants will be provided full accommodation and meals during the event (1st - 8th November 2026).

Important Notice on Visa Application for IOAA-jr 2026 Participants:

Although **nationals from 93 countries and territories** are entitled to visa exemption when entering Thailand, such exemptions apply only for purposes related to tourism, business engagements, urgent assignments, or ad-hoc work.

Therefore, the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) of IOAA-jr 2026, Thailand strongly recommends all participants to apply for a Courtesy Visa (CY), in accordance with the guidelines provided by the Department of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

Travel Insurance:

The organizers will provide Personal Accident Insurance covering only injuries resulting from accidents for all foreign participants during the event period (1–8 November 2026).

However, please noted that for any other illnesses or medical conditions not caused by an accident, travelers will be responsible for their own medical expenses. Therefore, it is highly recommended to purchase comprehensive Travel Insurance before arriving in Thailand.

Comprehensive travel insurance should cover:

- Medical emergencies
- Flight delays or cancellations
- Damage to personal belongings
- Lost or stolen luggage

To ensure adequate coverage, select a travel insurance policy specifically designed for travel in Thailand, as this will help avoid exclusions or unexpected conditions.
